

Moscow Avenue was left without lighting

On September 28, 1930 district of Moscow Avenue of the city of Yaroslavl was left without electricity. The lights went out in the area between the Moscow railway station and the bus station. The lack of electricity has affected residential homes infrastructure street lighting and traffic lights. From the latter formed a large congestion at the intersection of Moskovsky prospect and Frunze. To resolve the situation could have arrived employees of traffic police however, it took about half an hour to get to the ill-fated intersection. As have informed in MUP Yargorelectroset quarter remained without electricity as a result of the failure of 6 kV cable line. Eliminate the accident failed in the area of the 2200 the same day.
